

Mombasa Beach Unwind Extension

Nature Photography Adventures



At the end of a great safari one can jump on an airplane and head home – or, in this case, one can soak in the sounds of the beach at our Mombasa Beach Unwind Extension.

We'll come off the safari mid-day on February 12, and head straight to the Nomad Beach Resort near Mombasa, Kenya! Lodging is in cute cabanas facing a gently sloping beach onto the Indian Ocean.

We have planned an outing on February 13 into Mombasa to see the dhow harbor (dhows are traditional Kenyan outrigger craft), visit the bazaar, and the local market. We'll also find artists and artisans at work at the Akamba woodcarvers!



Lunch will be at the Tamarind Restaurant. Then, it's back to the beach where we've planned a dhow outing.

Other than that, the beach is yours to enjoy. Snorkeling, camel rides, kayaking, and sailboarding are available (at extra costs). We'll be there if you want photographic guidance.



On February 14, you'll be transferred to the Mombasa International Airport for a quick flight to Nairobi, where you'll be whisked to the Four Points Sheridan for a day room. There you can rest up, reunite with any luggage you left in Nairobi, and dine. You'll get one last transfer to Nairobi's Jomo Kenyatta International Airport to catch your flight home.

Breakfasts and dinners are included. Lunches, drinks, and laundry are on your own.



Price is \$1,400 per person double occupancy or \$1,800 single occupancy. You do have the option to stick around longer at \$350 per person, double occupancy or \$450 single occupancy per day added.
