Jul 10	Alternate early arrival (extra cost) Grand Hotel, Reykjavik – Check in 3 pm	No meals included
Jul 11	Arrival Day 5 pm gathering for orientation Grand Hotel, Reykjavik – Check in 3 pm	Welcome Dinner
Jul 12	We'll head to the interior of Iceland today! Expect a wild volcanic landscape with waterfalls, lakes, lava and ash. There may be some remnants of last winter's snows. Lodging at Hrauneyjar Highlands Center	All meals included
Jul 13	We'll work our way south through the highlands finding more dramatic volcanic landscapes, waterfalls, rivers to cross, and carpets of moss. Hotel Laki, near the coast	All meals included
Jul 14	We'll explore the craters from the famous Laki eruption and begin our exploration of Vatnajokull National Park. A good day to find arctic terns and maybe loons. Fosshotel Glacier Lagoon	All meals included
Jul 15	Puffin tour (including skuas)! Glacial lagoons! Black sand beach with stranded icebergs. Glacier views – and so much more! Fosshotel Glacier Lagoon	All meals included
Jul 16	We'll venture east of the Glacier Lagoon for more glaciers, waterfalls, abrupt volcanic peaks, dazzling coastline, and more! Fosshotel Glacier Lagoon	All meals included
Jul 17	We head west along the coast, photographing waterfalls, canyons, headland, fields of lupines, and more. Hotel Katla	All meals included
Jul 18	We'll push up and around the Katla Volcano. Waterfalls, big canyons, volcanic cones, plush mosses, so many landscape opportunities. A long day with many rewards. Hotel Katla	All meals included
Jul 19	A fun day along the coast, with gorgeous coastal cliffs, black sand beaches, waterfalls, and more – then we'll slip back up to Reykjavik for our final dinner together.	Breakfast and Lunch included. Final dinner (not included in program cost)
